RESTORATION AND PRESERVATIVE GOINGS SINCE ACQUIRED

Relined, cleaned and restored in dry colors and damar about 1930. 1955, red became darkened and stained. E. Modestini removed varnish and restoration. Relined with dry colors and damar, French varnish applied. Protective coating of 277 varnish. Good condition - some wear along the border of the painting.
