RESTORATION AND PROTECTOR COATING STAIN ACQUIRED

1931. Halfred, cleaned and restored with dry colors and deer oilskin. French varnish insulator. Bower varnish coating.
1962. Varnish had darkened and stains had formed.
N. Underneath removed varnish and restorations with solvents.
Applied coat of blackened varnish. Repainted with dry colors and brush, alcohol and Resin varnish. Protective coating of Spence varnish.
Fair condition.
Scale losses and abrasions throughout.
