RESTORATION AND PROTECTIVE GLAZING WORK SUMMARY

1950-51, bilateral secured and refined. Cleaned and restored with dry color and clear. French varnish isolator. Denser varnish protective coating.

1953, in bilateral condition and varnish had darkened and yellowed. M. Yoderstein secured bilateral and removed varnish with solvents. Reproduced with dry colors and tapestry. French varnish isolator. Applied coating of clear varnish.

A few restorations - Good condition.
