c. 1929 - Slight restoration with dry colors and damar varnish medium. French varnish isolator. Damar varnish coating.

1960 - M. Mostardini corrected a few stains with dry colors and Ayeh medium. Applied coat of Resbrant varnish.

Press original.

Central panel in very poor condition. 2 wings are slightly better.
