RESTORATION AND PROTECTIVE COATING STUDY SUMMARY

1948-9 Cradled and restored by M. Modestini with dry colors and egg tempera. French varnish isolator. Desser varnish coating.

1962 - M. Modestini cleaned dry with solvent, applied coat of Rembrandt varnish and inpainted with dry colors and wash, alcohol and beeswax mixture. Protective coating of Synvar varnish.

Abraded throughout - many restorations.
