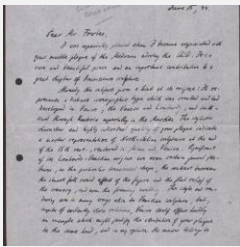

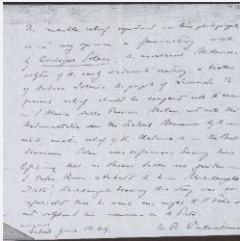

K1385 - Expert opinion by Swarzenski, 1944

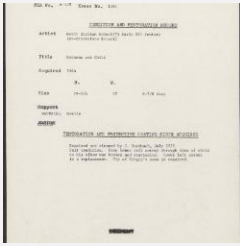


K1385 - Expert opinion by Valentiner, 1944
