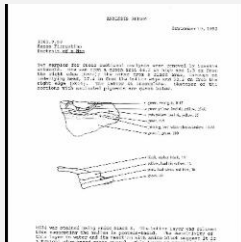

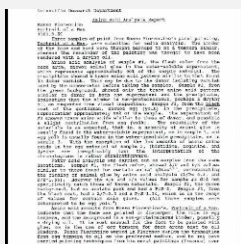

K1735 - Scientific analysis report, 1992

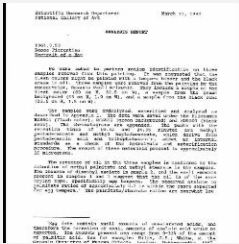


K1735 - Treatment report, 1993

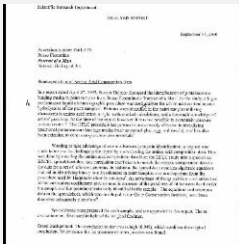

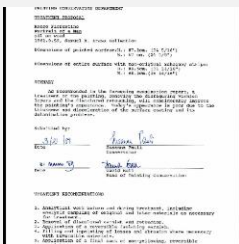

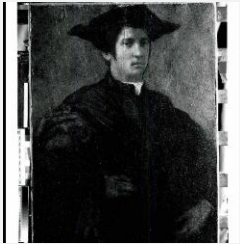
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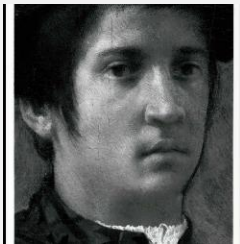
