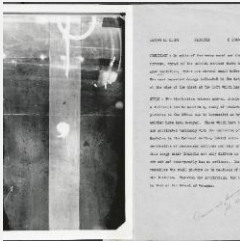

K1262 - Alan Burroughs report, circa 1930s-1940s

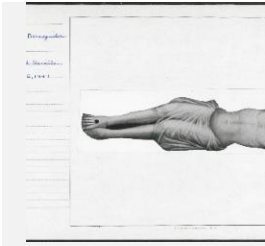


K1262 - Photograph, circa 1930s-1960s

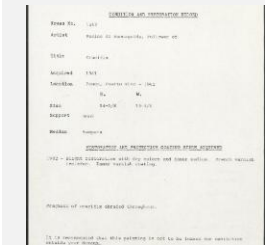
