It was lent by Paul Drey to the Seventh Anniversary Exhibition of German, Flemish and Dutch Painting, William Rockhill Nelson Gallery of Art, December 1940, no. 59.

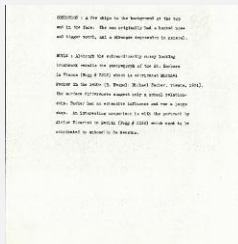

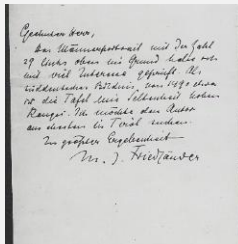

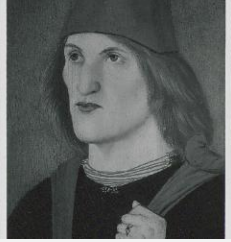
K1593 - Alan Burroughs report, circa 1930s-1940s
