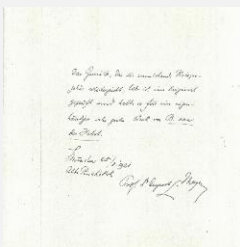

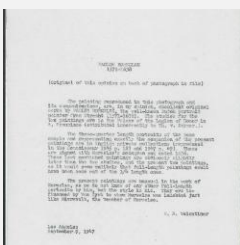
K1685 - Expert opinion by Mayer, 1921



K1685 - Condition and restoration record, circa 1950s-1960s

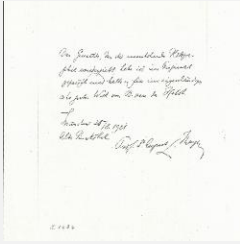


K1685 - Photograph, circa 1930s-1960s

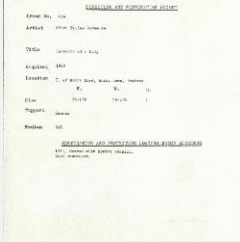


K1686 - Expert opinion by Valentiner, 1947
