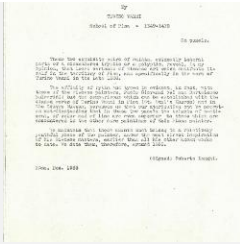


K0176 - Expert opinion by Perkins, circa 1920s-1940s

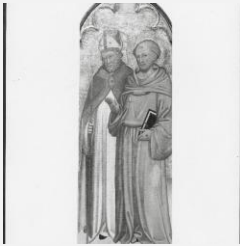

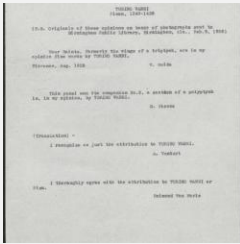
K0176 - Expert opinion by Longhi, 1933

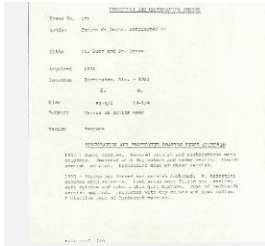


K0176 - Expert opinion by Fiocco et al., 1935
