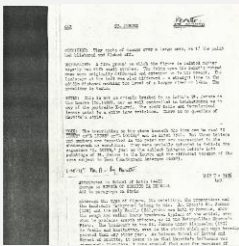

K0190 - Expert opinion by Berenson, circa 1920s-1950s

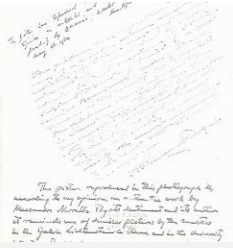


K0190 - Expert opinion by Longhi et al., circa 1920s-1950s

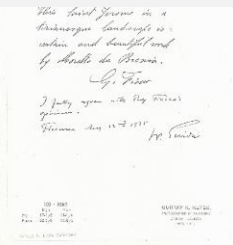
